

A Note from the Pastor

Mystic and theologian Henri Nouen wrote:

When God took on flesh in Jesus Christ, the uncreated and the created, the eternal and the temporal, the divine and the human became united. This unity meant that all that is mortal now points to the immortal, all that is finite now points to the infinite. In and through Jesus all creation has become like a splendid veil, through which the face of God is revealed to

This is called the sacramental quality of the created order. All that is is sacred because all that is speaks of God's redeeming love. Seas and winds, mountains and trees, sun, moon, and stars, and all the animals and people have become sacred windows offering us glimpses of God.

When we pay attention, all of creation has a story to tell of God's goodness, grace and love. God is also revealed in the Holy Scriptures, and of course, was best revealed in the Living Word, Jesus Christ. But all of creation also points to the Creator, if we but attend to the presence of God. As the psalmist said, "The heavens declare the glory of God."

This month we will share in a "Blessing of the Animals" on Saturday, October 3rd at 3:00 in the afternoon. It is one way to thank God for the gift of companionship offered through beloved pets, and to seek God's blessing on all of God's creatures.

We are also undertaking a new project to better utilize the gift of the historic cemetery across the street from Old Bergen Church. Plans are to make it into a memorial garden and park that will be accessible to the public during daylight hours. As the city grows we witness less and less green space where people can be refreshed by God's creation. Our hope is that we can offer a blessing to our community through our cemetery and soon to be memorial garden. Already city and county officials are excited to support and share in this effort to improve our neighborhood. "You shall be like a watered garden, like a spring of water, whose waters never fail. Your ancient ruins shall be rebuilt you shall raise up the foundations of many generations; you shall be called the repairer of the breach, the restorer of streets to live in." (Isaiah 58:11-12)

<u>OLD EYEGLASSES</u>- Old Bergen Sunday School sponsors an ongoing collection of old eye glasses, also including your unused glass cases. We will see that they get redistributed and recycled for a good cause through an organization that does exactly that. As of the last donation Old Bergen donated 30 pairs of glasses. Thank you for your donations.

FAMILY PROMISE – INTERFAITH FAMILY SHELTER-Area congregations continue to make plans for launching a housing alliance for homeless families in Hudson County. Did you know that there is no homeless shelter in Jersey City that currently can take a complete family unit with two parents or boys over the age of fourteen? We are seeking 13 congregations who can share in this project by providing overnight housing up to four weeks a year for two to four families at a time. Old Bergen has made a commitment to this project, which would include meals and overnight accommodations at the church for a week at a time. The project expects to get under way in 2016.

FOSTER CARE MENTOR PROGRAM- What happens when young people "age out" of the foster care system? Some fall through the cracks. Some turn to gang affiliation and crime. Some just wander through the challenges of life without any family, support, or connection. Volunteers at Temple Beth El are seeking volunteers who will serve as mentors to these young people. Specifically, they are looking for individuals who will meet once a month for a meal, to sit with a young person (ages 18 – 25) and accompany them on life's journey; one meal, once a month – usually on a Sunday evening. Please contact Pastor Jon if you are interested or if you would like to learn about this program.

- -Consistory has approved and we have moved into the planning stages for a new look to the cemetery. We will have some new landscaping done, a place to sit and reflect as well as a Column barium. We look forward to making our cemetery "A Space for Grace."
