The world is changing before our eyes. Who would have guessed 30 years ago that we would walk around with phones and miniature information systems with worldwide communication access right in the palm of our hands?! In our immediate neighborhood, we are witnessing change and growth. One of six high rises within five blocks of the church has already reached 36 of its proposed 53 stories! Within the next few years we will have thousands of new neighbors living within walking distance of our church. What are we doing to prepare for these changes?

The church is not known for its adaptation to change! We embrace eternal truths not subject to the winds of change. Yet, the even the prophet Isaiah reminds us that God is ready to do a new thing. The officers of Old Bergen are doing their best to discern the leading of God's Spirit to meet the needs of the present day. It does not benefit the church to make plans for people and a world which no longer exists. Here are a few ways that we are seeking to follow God's lead to live out the gospel of God's love:

- ~ This summer we installed a new lighted sign with LED digital messaging capabilities. No longer will people say that Old Bergen is just a closed museum. We are able to promote worship, fellowship and outreach activities for all to see.
- ~ We are in the final stages of redesigning our church's website. Most new residents begin their search for a worshiping community by looking online. The redesign includes a welcome video, real time updates on the church's event calendar, and recordings of sermons.
- ~ We recognize that God has given us the gift of one of the few diminishing green spaces in our neighborhood namely our historic cemetery. We are working to transform our cemetery into a memorial garden open to the public. Key leaders have commented on both the historical significance of our church and the impressive relevant potential of our congregation. Old Bergen is emerging as a beacon and leader in this community again!
- ~ At the same time, we realize our responsibility to care for "the least of these". We are now a charter congregation of Family Promise; an interfaith shelter for homeless families with children. We are also active in a community coalition of congregations soon to be known as Jersey City Together. This faith-based group is aimed at finding solutions to our city's most pressing needs to improve the quality of life for all its residents.

Yes, in the midst of change God is doing a new thing! Won't you join in "Making a Space for Grace" here at Old Bergen Church!



### Deacons' News

The deacons had a very productive meeting this past month. The Deacons have recently sent support to Church World Service for relief work among those affected by the devastating flooding. We also sent a contribution to the local Church World Service refugee resettlement program to assist with the needs of a family who recently arrived fleeing the violence in Syria. Your gifts are making an impact around the world! Plans are in the works for a social group to meet at the church. We want to thank everyone who attended the Fall Harvest Dinner on October 11 for their food donations and also financial assistance. We will be restocking the Care Notes pamphlets on various topics. We decided to support the missionaries in Sudan for another 3 years. Also, we had discussion to possibly add CWS in Jersey City to the benevolence for their work with the refugees. There is a conference for Stephens Ministers in January so if anyone is interested in this and need scholarships apply for the ones Stephens Ministers offer and then if needed the deacons can assist in the cost. The deacons will also recreate the Lay Pastoral Care to keep in touch with church members and visitors. The deacons will once again give Christmas gifts to the shut-ins. Finally, if you know of a member who needs a pastoral call please let the church office know so Pastor can take care of visiting them.

Also time to help support the Deacons' project "No Crib for a Bed"! So, when you purchase your 2015 Christmas cards buy them from the Deacons! One card shows the Old Bergen Church Live Nativity and the other shows the Candlelight Service. The project helps support Women Rising! The cards are discounted this year. The cards are 10 cards and 10 envelopes per pack and cost \$7.00. The cards will be on display at the coffee hours. If you would like to buy some packs please see a Deacon. 
### **Deacons' Corner**

Community Outreach—We have been helping the local office of Church World Service in their ministry of refugee resettlement. Six families have been settled this year. Donations of household goods, linens, and clothing to the church and CWS will pick them up.

### <u>FAMILY PROMISE –</u> <u>INTERFAITH FAMILY</u>

SHELTER- Did you know that there is no homeless shelter in Jersey City that currently can take a complete family unit with two parents or boys over the age of fourteen? Old Bergen has made a commitment to this project, which would include meals and overnight accommodations at the church for a week at a time. The project expects to get under way in 2016.

### FOSTER CARE MENTOR

PROGRAM- They are looking for individuals who will meet once a month for a meal, to sit with a young person (ages 18 – 25) and accompany them on life's journey; one meal, once a month – usually on a Sunday evening. 
